5. Literacy campaign:-

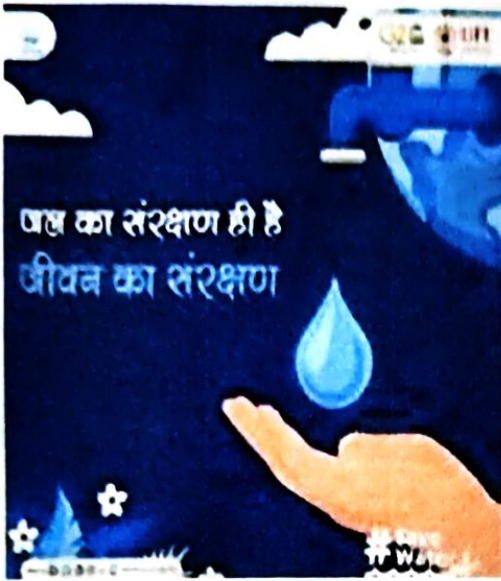
