

The Child Sex Ratio (CSR) leads us to the gender biased sex selection involving parents and pathological technicians. Studies and rules against this selection are still a far cry from success. Attempts are being made from the local to the global level to curb this practice. To regulate such malpractices the government has brought the 1994 act on the Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuses). This Act

lays down strict rules on prohibition of sex selection and sex revelation of the foetus. Save the child foundation reveals the state of girls in society and the need for a better tomorrow for them. Society has to fight the stereotype mental setup of autocratic beliefs, early marriage as a solution for the fear of being a victim of abuse."

Asst. Prof. Mr. Vinod Kumar Suman addressed that "Mother is the first teacher of her child, if the mother is well educated then she can provide proper education to her child. If the girl child will be educated properly then she can create a well culture educated family. There for everybody should be conscious about the girl child education."

Conclusion:

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao campaign today played a vital role in changing the mind-sets of the villagers, and become aware about Girl Child's Education. This type of awareness programme will be helpful in the improvement of the Sex Ratio at Birth (SRB), and in the long term, BBBP aims in improvement in CSR with manifestation of over-all development such as improved health & nutrition, gender parity in education, better sanitation, opportunities and removal of asymmetries between the genders.



Mr. Binod Kumar Suman said that- Holi is celebrated in the middle of the spring and summer seasons. Following the day one celebrations,






