There are resources available all around you that you can use in the classroom, that can help your students' learning.

On this occasion, Principal of the college, Dr. Ajit Kumar Singh said that-You will find people in your immediate environment who are versed in a wide variety of subjects; You will also find many types of natural resources. This allows you to make connections with the local community, demonstrate its importance, encourage students to see the abundance and diversity of their environment, and perhaps most importantly, take a holistic approach to the learning of students – that is, within the college and Working toward adopting outside education may help.

Today, in this program, the B.Ed trainees along with the teachers first understood how different types of materials are made from bamboo and how it is easily available to all of us, which included things made from bamboo like moni, soup, basket etc. People who are expert in making such material can make it very easily, whereas we fail to make the same things.

After this, all the B.Ed trainees went to a maker of different types of items from clay, where they saw that a potter was making different types of items from the same type of clay, which mainly included cups, pots, pitchers, Items like jug etc. were included. Here, the teachers and trainees also tried to operate the potter's wheel on which various objects are made by placing clay on it, but failed. Because it is not possible to learn it in one go, it is the result of continuous effort.




REPORT


