3. **Objectifying Women:** Today's dowry is more equivalent to a financial investment by the Bride's family to get access to powerful connections and lucrative business possibilities. As a result, women are reduced to commodities.
4. **Crime Against Women:** Domestic violence includes the violence and murders related to dowry demands. Physical, mental, economic violence, and harassment as a way of enforcing compliance or punishing the victim are all utilized in dowry-related offenses, similar to domestic violence.



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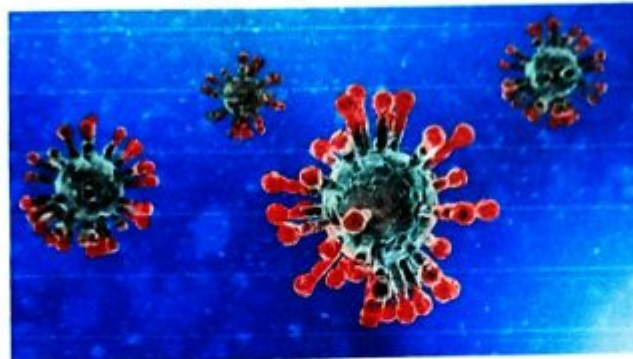
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PROTECTION IN COVID-19

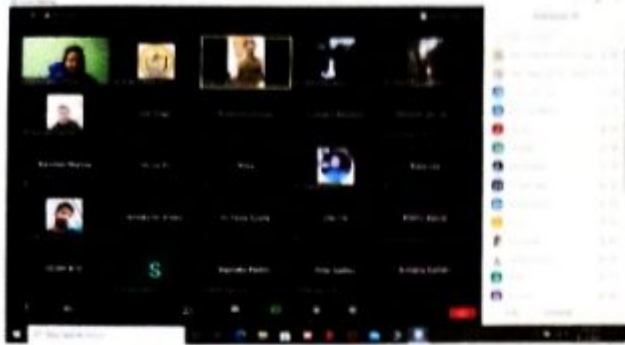

The dowry system predates the British period and colonization in India. In those days, dowry was not considered "money" or a "fee" that the Bride's parents had to pay. One of the fundamental purposes of dowry was it acted as a form of protection for the wife against the ill-treatment by her husband and his family. The dowry system can put great financial burden on the bride's family. In some cases, the dowry system leads to crimes against women, ranging from emotional abuse and injury to even deaths.

On this occasion, Principal of the college, Dr. Ajit Kumar Singh said that- Dowry is a social evil in society that has caused unimaginable tortures and crimes towards women and polluted the Indian marital system. Dowry is payment made in cash or kind to a bride's in-laws at the time of her marriage.

Mr. Pavan Kumar Suman said that- Dowry Harassment is torturing a wife for money, property, or other valuable assets by a husband or his family and relatives. It is a punishable offence under the law but still practiced in many rural areas of India.
